Taehangno was the site of Seoul National University until 1975 and still retains its reputation as a performing arts hot spot. The underground music scene here is huge and Korean university students are very passionate about their favorite bands. You won't find too many hip-hop bars here though - most of the music here is rock n' roll, jazz, and alternative. Chunyunis is a favorite spot that features jazz musicians, funk bands, and even Caribbean-style music. In addition, many free performances are given by street performers as well as by production companies. There are many small venues where plays and concerts are held. Marronnier Park is a wonderful place to visit. It's a huge open area where plays, concerts, and comedies are acted out daily. During the weekend, the park is crammed full of people. While Taehangno was once filled with student demonstrators, it has become a hub for young people and artists alike. Many young people come to Taehangno because of its lively atmosphere.
