COEX Mall is the largest underground shopping and entertainment complex in Asia. The mall consists of hundreds of restaurants, movie theaters, department stores, clothing stores, clubs, bookstores and arcades.

COEX Aquarium brings you into the fascinating underwater world and allows you to view a variety of aquatic life and learn about their marine habitats.

The aquarium is the largest in Korea and home to over 500 varieties of underwater creatures. The aquarium's glass submarine tunnel lets you feel as if you're walking underwater! COEX Aquarium's Journey-of-Water theme begins with the Inca Empire through to the Amazon on to Deep Blue Sea.

Bongunsa Temple is located south of Seoul. It served as one of the nation's leading Buddhist seminaries since its construction in the 10th century. It has a unique wooden structure called Seonbuldang, which is one of the most famous Buddhist buildings in Korea. Traditional Korean musical instruments are also on display at the temple beyond a statue of young Buddha.
